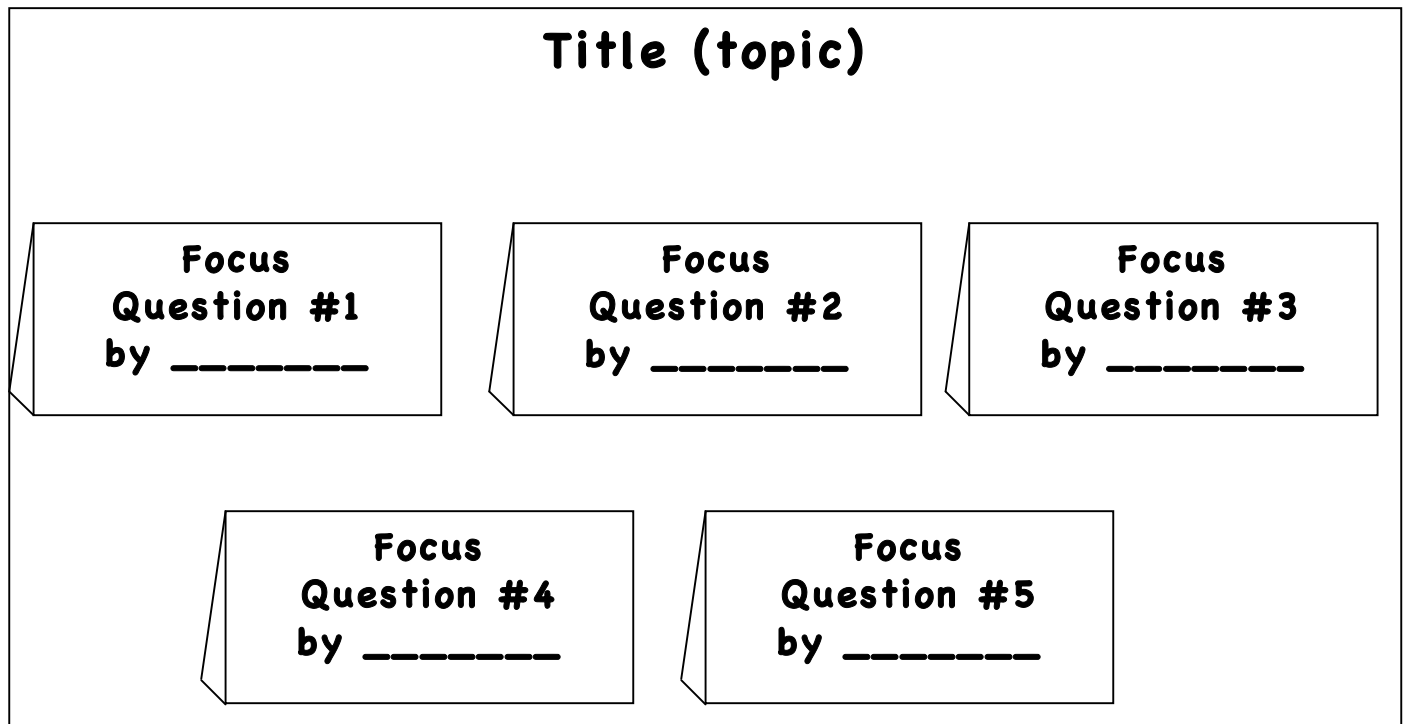


Q & A Flap Board (Foam Board) Requirements

- Title your Q & A flap board with the topic that your group researched (e.g., Holidays).
 - Make 5 flaps made out of construction paper (one for each focus question).
 - Type each focus question, along with the first name of the person who researched it. The focus questions should be single-spaced, and in a font that is large enough to read from a couple of feet away. Neatly glue one focus question to the outside of each flap.
 - Glue each focus question answer page underneath the correct flap. **Do not include a title on the focus question answer page since it is already on the flap.**
 - Glue the completed flaps to your Q & A flap board.
 - Decorate the rest of the Q & A flap board with pictures, diagrams, illustrations, and symbols that are related to your group's topic. Be creative!
- Sample Flap Board Layout:

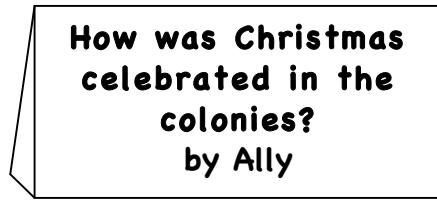


Your Q & A flap board does not have to be arranged in exactly the same way, but it must follow all of the requirements!
